Parent/Family Leadership Series:

Opportunities to learn about educational topics related to learners with disabilities

Starting December 11, 2008, State Support Team 13, in collaboration with regional trainers, will offer interactive, hands-on, sessions related to Special Education System topics. Family members **may attend any or all** sessions. *A \$20 gift card, to help defray expenses, will be provided to parents and family members at each session (one gift card per family).*

Sessions will be held at CRES (former SERRC building), from 6:00 – 8:30 PM, the 2nd Thursday each month, December through May. The sessions will cover basic information about topics related to the needs of learners with disabilities, including an intervention/prevention model for learners who are not successful in school, academically or behaviorally. Ohio's new Operating Standards will be applied to each topic area.

Those who attend all six Series sessions will be invited to attend a more advanced, in-depth, training at a Spring Leadership Institute May 28, and June 2nd and 4th, 2009.

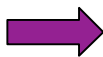
